PRO FOOTBALL HALL OF FAME MEMBER LEM BARNEY TO APPEAR AT JACKSON TOUCHDOWN CLUB

(JACKSON, MS) The Jackson Touchdown Club will present its 6th meeting of the season on Monday, October 12, 2009, at 6:00 PM at the River Hills Tennis Club located at the intersection of Ridgewood Road and Lakeland Drive in Jackson. Former Jackson State and Detroit Lion star Lem Barney will be the featured speaker.

Barney, a native of Gulfport, was a three-time All SWAC player at Jackson State from 1963-67. He was a member of the Detroit Lions from 1967-1978 where he was a 7-time Pro Bowl selection and a 3-time All Pro. Lem is a member of the Jackson State Athletic Hall of Fame (1983), the Michigan Sports Hall of Fame (1985), the Detroit Lions Hall of Fame (1980), the Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame (1986), and the Pro Football Hall of Fame (1992). In 1993, he was named to the All-Time Black College Football Team as selected by Sheridan Broadcasting.
