FORMER ALL-PRO & JSU STAR HAROLD JACKSON TO APPEAR AT THE JACKSON TOUCHDOWN CLUB

(JACKSON, MS) The Jackson Touchdown Club will present its 7th meeting of the season on Monday, October 19, 2009, at 6:00 PM at the River Hills Tennis Club located at the intersection of Ridgewood Road and Lakeland Drive in Jackson. Former Jackson State and All Pro wide receiver Harold Jackson will be the guest speaker.

Jackson hails from Hattiesburg and played for Jackson State from 1965 to 1968. He was selected in the 12th round of the 1968 NFL Draft, the 323rd player selected overall, by the Los Angeles Rams. Harold spent 16 years in the NFL with the Rams, Philadelphia, New England, Minnesota, and Seattle. He led the NFL in receptions in 1972 and in receiving yardage in 1969 and 1972. During his career, he was named All-Pro on 5 occasions. He was also named to the NFL All-Decade Team for the 1970's.

After his retirement, Jackson coached receivers for 10 years in the league at New England, Tampa Bay, and New Orleans. He also coached receivers at Baylor. Harold was inducted into the Jackson State Athletic Hall of Fame in 1984. He currently resides in Los Angeles, California.
